TERMS & CONDITIONS

Selection & Acceptance Process

Submitting an application does not confirm your space and does not constitute a contractual agreement. If your application is selected, you will be notified via email and a deposit payment will be requested to reserve your spot. It is possible that not all applicants will receive a space inside the Food Truck area. Furthermore, HopeFest reserves the rights to refuse applications that do not meet the standards or needs set for the festival.

Food Truck Vendor (herein, "Food Vendor") understands that acceptance of the application and agreement is within the sole discretion of Wings for Widows. Further, in the event Wings for Widows accepts this application and agreement, Food Vendor shall be bound by the terms and conditions stated herein.

All applications must be filled out completely and legibly.

Deadline for Applications

The deadline to submit applications is April 1, 2022.

Event Fee and Deposit

Many festival events charge an entry fee and often share in the gross proceeds from the event. Wings for Widows has decided not to charge Food Vendors an entry fee nor share in the gross proceeds for this event this year. We consider it a privilege to have you join us for the inaugural year of HopeFest 2022.

IF YOU ARE SELECTED and wish to participate, Wings for Widows will request a \$500 deposit from you to reserve your spot. This deposit will be returned to you following the event if all Terms and Conditions were met. Your spot will be held but is NOT reserved until payment is received. Please submit the deposit promptly. Make check payable to Wings for Widows.

Licenses and Insurance

Food Vendors must be licensed by Hennepin County and insured in accordance with state and local regulations. If you are not licensed in Plymouth, you will need to get licensed and provide proof of such license if you are selected as an official Food Vendor. Please do not apply for selection if you do not intend to be licensed in the City of Plymouth using one of three options:

Set-Up & Tear-Down

Food Vendors will be located on the HopeFest festival grounds. Set-up time for vendors shall be Sunday, August 21 from 7:00 to 10:00 a.m. We cannot accommodate any other times for set up. All Food Vendors must be ready by 12:00 p.m. when gates open to the public.

Tear-down of your truck and departure from the festival grounds cannot take place any earlier than 10:00 p.m. on Sunday, August 21.

Additional information will be provided to selected vendors later.

Food Service Hours

Food Vendors are to remain open and manned throughout the one-day festival, from noon to 10 p.m. You will be instructed onsite if you can close down earlier.

Electricity

Food Vendors will be provided with one 50 amp, 120/240 and two 110 receptacles for your convenience at no cost. You can use your generator(s) if you prefer.

Event Tickets

Each Food Vendor receives two General Admission tickets. Any additional tickets required are available at advertised prices.

Parking

Prior to the event you will receive an event map, indicating the Food Vendor area. Spots are 25' x 25' and should accommodate most food trucks. Wings for Widows reserves the right to assign parking spots.

Internet Wireless

A high-speed internet connection will be available on the festival grounds at no charge for vendors only.

Festival Survey

Near the end of the event, you will be provided a Festival Survey to complete prior to departing the festival grounds. A volunteer will come by to collect the survey. It will provide us some immediate feedback about your experience as a festival vendor. We assure you it will only take a few minutes to complete. Thank you in advance.

Cancellation

If you cancel for any reason on or before June 1, 2022, you forfeit your \$500 deposit.

Due to possible conditions that may be beyond our control, such as weather, natural or international disaster, etc., HopeFest may be postponed or canceled. In this case, your deposit would be returned.

Vendor Risk & Liability

Food Vendor acknowledges that Wings for Widows has provided and informed you that the Food Vendor area is not secure, and Wings for Widows does not guarantee the security or safety of Food Vendor property, assets, or sales receipts, and further hereby Food Vendor agrees to accept full responsibility for the same.

Food Vendor agrees to indemnify and hold Wings for Widows harmless from any and all claims, cause of action, suits, or demands for liability, damage, loss, expense arising from any injury to persons or property which may occur in relation or connection to Merch Vendors/Exhibitors and its agents, representatives, employees, guests, or customers activities, acts, actions, failures or omissions in relation to the festival at any time before, during or after the same.

Food Vendor acknowledges that banners, flyers, posters, stickers, or other material are NOT to be posted or distributed anywhere on the festival grounds except within your Food Truck area.

Proof of Insurance

Wings for Widows requires proof of insurance from each Food Vendor once vendor has been selected as an official vendor. Food Vendor must provide a current Certificate of Liability with \$1 million (minimum) coverage listing Wings for Widows as an additional insured. Proof of insurance must be provided to Wings for Widows by June 1, 2022.

COVID-19 Policy

Policy information will be provided prior to the event. All policies will be strictly enforced.

Program Advertising

If you have any interest in advertising in our festival program, please contact vendors@Hope-Fest.org. Cost is \$75. The deadline for reserving a space would be July 1, 2022.

HopeFest Rights

The sales of CD's and other forms of music are regulated by Wings for Widows and Wings for Widows reserves the right to appoint the provider of artist merchandise and music. Artists sell merchandise in their designated booth areas. Wings for Widows has exclusive rights to the sale of glow products. Wings for Widows reserves the right to deny sales of certain items to encourage diversity. The name Wings for Widows and/or HopeFest (in any form) is not to be used or affiliated with your organization in any way. HopeFest management reserves the right to approve or remove literature or materials at their discretion. Wings for Widows reserves the right to assign all Food Vendor locations and, if necessary, shut down your operations. If there is any unlawful behavior occurring in or around your Food Truck during the festival, HopeFest security will report it immediately to the proper authorities.
